


The alphabetical subject indexing for the Subject Index is particularly for detailed accounts of bird species and groups and birding areas; topics related to bird identification, banding, distribution, breeding studies, ecology, habitat, and other important subjects; notation of first records as well as unaccepted first records from the CFO Records Committee Reports; CFO field trip reports; and various selected items. Every paper is referred to by subject words taken from the title and selected key subjects from its text. The names of species in the Subject Index are those used in the indexed paper and no attempt has been made to update or change to various AOU listings during the 1967-2000 period. A detailed, extensive compilation such as this will have some errors and omissions; please report them to either the compiler or the Editor of JCFO. Thanks are due to CFO member Mona Hill for providing a complete set of journals.

The original name of the journal was *The Colorado Field Ornithologists* from the winter 1967 no. 1 issue through Sept/Dec 1974, no. 21/22 issue. The name became *C.F.O. Journal*, *The Colorado Field Ornithologists Quarterly* with the spring 1975, no. 23 issue. Later the name was changed from *C.F.O. Journal* to *Colorado Field Ornithologists Journal* with the fall 1991, v. 25, no. 4 issue. In 1997, the name was changed to *Journal of the Colorado Field Ornithologists*, *The CFO Quarterly* with the 1997 volume 31, no. 1 issue.

The format of the journal began as a booklet 5" by 8" size (same as today), center bound, offset printed in black and white, cover with drawings or photos until 1971 with the no. 9 issue. Because of financial problems, the format was changed with the 1971 no. 10 issue to 8" inch by 11 inch size bound by two staples on the left side printed by "quick-copy method," which continued through the 1975 spring no. 23 issue. With the next issue, the format was changed back to the small size. The Journal was published as a biannual from

the initial winter 1967 no. 1 issue through the November 1971 no. 10 issue. It became a quarterly with the March 1972 issue. In 1974, the last two numbers, no. 21/22, were combined into one printing. Pagination started with one for all numbered issues, no. 1 through no. 34.

In accordance to the U.S. Postal Service regulations, the page numbering system of the Journal was changed to the volume/number sequence with the fall, 1978 issue, which is v. 12, no. 4, p. 1–44; the 1978 summer issue is no. 34, the 1978 spring issue is no. 33, and the 1978 winter issue is no. 32; pagination in each starts with 1. In 1974, the pagination of each volume was to start with 1 in the first number and is continue through four numbers. However, it took a bit of time to meet this requirement. Pagination of both numbers 1 and 2 for 1979, v. 13 start with 1 and number 3 starts with 61. Number 2 was later (1979, p. 90) corrected by adding 28 to each page number of that issue. Pagination of the 1983, no. 1 and no. 3 issues also started with 1. Because of this the Subject Index shows numbers for these mis-paginated numbers (for example, Arkansas Valley: 1979, no. 2, p. 3–6). Since then, the pagination is continuous throughout each volume, and numbers are shown in the Subject Index only where necessary.

Articles and short notes of general or scientific interest are solicited; potential authors are encouraged to submit any materials that contribute to the enjoyment and understanding of birds in Colorado. The preferred submission format is electronic, via e-mail attachment or on an IBM-formatted 3.5" diskette. Typed or hand-written manuscripts are also accepted.

Photos or art: submit black & white or color material (generally published in black & white); slides or prints are accepted; scanned TIFF (*.tif) images can be submitted via e-mail, 3.5" diskette, or CD. Include information about photos/art/graphics (what/where/when/whom, medium used, etc.).

Art and photos will be returned to you; manuscripts and diskettes will not be returned unless specifically requested. While your materials will receive the utmost care, the Colorado Field Ornithologists (CFO), or any person belonging to CFO, cannot be responsible for materials lost in the mail or due to other circumstances beyond our control.

Manuscripts reporting formal scientific research are sent out for peer review.

Contributors who are not members of CFO will receive a complimentary copy of the *Journal*.

Deadlines for submissions are: **December 1 for January issue, March 1 for April issue, May 10 for July issue, and September 1 for October issue**.
